

Solvay Group Volunteering Day 2020:

We teach children to safety and save children lives

Solvay Sodi's initiative "With a seat belt in the back seat" started in 2015. In 2016, we conducted a large-scale campaign with more than 200 volunteers, which reached about 15,000 children.

Since 2017, the initiative has been under the patronage of the President of the Republic of Bulgaria. The campaign enjoys the support of various institutions and many partners. Our goal is to teach children (from 1st to 4th grade) safe behavior in the car: always sit in the back seat, on a specially designed seat, with a properly fastened seat belt.

The project continued in 2020, as part of the international volunteering day of the Solvay Group. We organized it in an innovative, digital way: 4 days, 24 online presentations, 3300

children, 17 schools in Varna and the region.
All of these 3,300 kids are now proud
seat belt inspectors and know
that seat belts save lives!

New investment

Solvay Sodi has received a Class "A" Investment Certificate from the Bulgarian Investment Agency for its "Bicarbonate of Soda Production, Packaging and Storage Facility" project, which will increase the production capacity of this product to 200,000 tons at the plant in Devnia. The implementation of the project will meet the increased needs for bicarbonate used in animal feed (Bicarez), flue gas cleaning (Solvair) and other applications.

Solvay Sodi is one of the largest investors in Bulgaria, a two-time winner of the prestigious national award "INVESTOR OF THE YEAR" in 1997 and 2007.







The JUBILEE 20-th edition of the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films in Bulgaria, Varna will be held in June 14th – 18th 2023.

This edition is a review of the rich history of the Festival and its role in revealing the international contribution of Red Cross and Red Crescent societies members with their devotedness to help the people all over the world. The International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films proves its role as international forum of humanity and solidarity and a place to exchange experience. Untill now, the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films is an unique event of its kind in the world.

In **1965** the Bulgarian Red Cross celebrates its **80**th jubilee. One of the events to

mark this jubilee is the founding of the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films, with the help of the Bulgarian Cinematography and the League of Red Cross and the Red Crescent Societies, presented by Marc Gazay. The second Festival in 1967 is organized under the patronage of the League and UNESCO, and later the World Health Organization aslojoins.

In 1973 /June, 18-27/ at its fifth edition, the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films is inscribed among the great world film festivals by reason of its recognition to "A" Category by the International Federation of Film Producers' Association and the International Film and Television Council.

Its tenth edition, the former JUBILEE of the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films, was held from 16 to 25 June 1983.

The Festival was attended by the International Committee of the Red Cross. President Mr. Alexander Hay, the President of the League, Mr. Enrique de la Mata and the





Chairman of the Standing Commission, Dr. Ahmed Abu Qura. Mr. Hans Hoegh, Secretary General of the League, Dr. Kiril Ignatov, President of the Bulgarian Red Cross.

Mr. Enrique de la Mata considers the extreme importance of the Festival to call for the respect and defense of human values; the Festival contributes to humanism in the world, to the preservation of peace and life; the Festival is an expression of the ideas of the international Red Cross movement.

Mr. Alexander Hay emphasizes the role and perseverance of the Bulgarian Red Cross, despite the difficulties, for the creation and transformation of the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films into one of the most important centers for communication between the representatives of the Red Cross movement.

Participants and guests of the Festival during the years have been: José Barroso Chávez, President of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies; Cornelio Sommaruga, President of the International Committee of the Red Cross; Alexandre Hay, President of the Internationa Committee of the Red Cross; Pär Stenbäck, General secretary of the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies; Alain Modoux, Head, Communication Department, International Committee of the Red Cross, Geneva, Mario Enrique Villarroel Lander, President of the International League of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, Henrik Beer, Secretary General of the League of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, Marcel Naville, President of the International Committee of the Red Cross.

Since 2014, the Bulgarian Red Cross revived of the Festival together with the Medical University of Varna, supported by the Municipality of Varna, under the patronage of the Vice-president of the Republic of Bulgaria and with the assistance of the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies.







BULGARIAN RED CROSS

The Bulgarian Red Cross carries out its activities in pursuit of its main objective to alleviate and prevent human suffering with impartiality and neutrality, without discrimination as to nationality or race, gender, social status, religious belief or political stand.

The Bulgarian Red Cross is a voluntary organization, part of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement and is guided by its Fundamental Principles: Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality.

Through its countrywide network of volunteers, the BRC renders assistance to the vulnerable people in situations of disaster and crisis. By means of training programmes and activities for the benefit of the public, the National Society contributes to alleviating and preventing the suffering in all its

forms, it protects health and life and ensures respect for the human being.

In compliance with its humanitarian mission, the Bulgarian Red Cross implements various activities to alleviate vulnerability, prevent the social exclusion of the most marginalized people and improve the quality of their life. It provides services and caries out various initiatives and campaigns related to protecting the human life and health, including promotion of health culture, first aid, road safety and others.

Bulgarian Red Cross supports the State in situations of disasters, accidents, crises and armed conflicts. The organization is part of the Unified Rescue System in Bulgaria.

The Bulgarian Youth Red Cross, through its thousands of volunteers, carries out activities throughout the country, for promotion of humanitarian values, prevention of violence and socially significant diseases, disseminating healthy lifestyle practices among children and young people, training in first aid, first psychological aid and psychosocial support.

Through its Mountain Rescue Service, the Bulgarian Red Cross assists the victims of mountain incidents and its Water Rescue Service ensures the training of qualified lifeguards and works towards prevention of water traumatism.









MEDICAL UNIVERSITY VARNA

The Medical University of Varna was established in 1961 and is named after Prof. Dr. Paraskev Stoyanov – the person who laid the foundations of the surgical school in the history of medicine in Bulgaria.

The Medical University of Varna offers high quality education. It is the first and only university in the country which in 2008 introduced the model of Business Excellence of the European Foundation for Quality management. The diplomas issued by the University are recognized in all European countries.

The attractive multinational environment, the hi-tech methods and means of training, education in real and simulation learning environment, the wonderful conditions for sports in the sea capital are only some of the reasons for which for which the Medical University of Varna is chosen for their studies by students from Bulgaria and 53 countries around the world.

Over 5000 students, postgraduates and PhD students are currently trained at the Faculties of Medicine, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy and Public Health, at the Medical College and the affiliates in Sliven, Veliko Turnovo and Shumen. The higher school has more than 80 international partners from 5 continents.

The University is proud of the sports achievements of its disciples in swimming, football, volleyball, basketball, tennis, handball and boxing. It has a team in sailing which takes part in competitions with its own wind sailing boat. The theatre group "Infarct" and the students' dancing group "Diana" at the Medical University win numerous prizes at national and international competitions.

The University is also developing activities to the benefit of society by initiating and conducting a number of social, health and information campaigns organized by students and members of the academic staff such as blood donation, the campaigns "Diabetes" and anti-aids, the students' campaign "Without cigarette smoke" promoting oral health and many others.

DR. STEFAN KOMANDAREV Bulgaria Chairman of the Jury

Stefan Komandarev is among the most established names in contemporary Bulgarian cinema. His film "The World is Big and Salvation Lies Everywhere" (2008) was the first Bulgarian feature film to be shortlisted for the Oscar. He was born in Sofia, graduated from the Medical Academy in 1993, and in 1999 - film direction at the New Bulgarian University. He is a member of the Bulgarian Association of Film Directors, the Union of Bulgarian Filmmakers, a part-time teacher at the NBU - feature film directing, a member of the European Film Academy. His filmography includes: the documentaries "The Path of Harmony" (2001), "Bread over the Fence" (2002), "Alphabet of Hope" (2003), "The City of Badante Women" (2009), "The Ruse Blood Wedding" (2009) and the full-lengths Dog Board (2000), The World Is Big and Salvation Lurks Everywhere (2008), The Courthouse (2014), Directions (2017) and In Circle (2019). The documentary "Life from Life" by director Stefan Komandarev won the grand prize at the 19th edition of the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films in 2021.



JOANNA BUKOVSKA Bulgaria

Joanna Bukovska – Davidova was born in Gabrovo. She graduated from the 9th French language high school "Alphonse de Lamartine" in Sofia. In 2000, she graduated from NATFIZ "Kr. Sarafov" in the class of Prof. Snezhina Tankovska and Associate Professor Andrey Batashov. Ioana Bukovska - Davidova starred in many films and TV series, including "Emilia's Friends" (1996), "Dog Boarding House" (2000), "Over the Line" (2003), "My Little Thing" (2007), "Seamstresses" (2007), "Naive" (2008), "Spotlights" (2009), "Undercover" (2011-2016), "Victor Young Perez" (2013), "Stolen Life" (2016 - 2017) and others. Winner of international and national theater and film awards.

In her career, Bukovska participated in dozens of theater productions performed on the stage of the "Bulgarian Army" Theater, "Valentin Stoychev" Theater 199, "Sofia" Theater and others. On the small screen, he became extremely popular with his participation in the Bulgarian series "Danube Bridge".





VIKTOR BOZHINOV Bulgaria

Viktor Bozhinov graduated from the "Film and TV Directing" specialty at NATFIZ "Kr. Sarafov" with artistic supervisor Prof. Hr. Christov. While studying, his coursework was selected in some of the most prestigious international short film festivals (Munich, Oberhausen, Tampere, Clermont-Ferrand, Drama). He has worked with world names in cinema such as Regis Varnier, Volker Schlöndorff, the Taviani brothers, Timur Bekmambetov, Uli Edeli Michael Apted.

After 2009, he actively participated in the creation of the new wave of successful Bulgarian television series. He directed and consulted on the production of a large part of the episodes of "Glass House", "Stolichani in more", "Kantora Mitrani", "Relationships". Together with producers Dimitar Mitovski and Ivan Doikov, he participated in the creation of the most successful Bulgarian television series "Undercover", produced by BNT. During the period 2015-2017, he worked on his first full-length feature film "Exaltation", based on the novel by Milen Ruskov, which became the most watched Bulgarian film for the last 8 years.



YURIY DACHEV Bulgaria

Associate Professor Yuriy Dachev is a famous Bulgarian playwrighter, screenwriter, director, critic and journalist. He was born in Shumen. Graduated from "Theatre Studies" at VITIZ "Krastyo Sarafov". As a scholarship holder of the Silvio d'Amico Academy, he specialized in "Theatre History and Theater Criticism" under Prof. Cesare Molinari at the University of Florence, Italy; participated in the drama school of the Royal Court Theater in London; is a fellow of KulturKontakt, Austria; he is a consultant at the Biennale of Drama in Bonn. He is a teacher at the "Theatre Science" department of NATFIZ "Krastyo Sarafov", repertoire director and dramaturgical consultant at the Small City Theater "Behind the Canal".

Part of the rich creative biography of Prof. Yuriy Dachev are the many author's dramaturgical texts, which received over 60 stage realizations, awarded with a number of awards, among them for dramaturgy of the Union of Artists in Bulgaria, "Chudomir" and others. Prof. Dachev is the author or co-author of nearly 15 realized screenplays for feature films and documentaries, many of which have been awarded prestigious awards at film festivals in Plovdiv, Varna and Wiesbaden, Germany. He is the author of more than 2,000 publications in the field of theater.





BEJAY BROWNE Cyprus

Bejay Browne is a female filmmaker, TV and radio producer, writer, presenter and journalist living in Cyprus.

A committed philanthropist, humanitarian and supporter of equal rights, she founded the Cyprus Hearts of Gold awards in 2007, which recognises outstanding children and adults from all over the island.

The film maker spent much of her childhood in Paphos and moved to Cyprus permanently in 2006, where she has worked at TV and radio stations-as a producer, director and presenter. She currently hosts the Breakfast Show on Rock FM Cyprus.

In 2008, Bejay joined the Cyprus Mail newspaper where she still works as a journalist and correspondent. The publication is the island's leading English language daily and has been in operation for more than 70 years.

Bejay also has a small film production company, 'In Focus Films', which creates original content, documentaries and films.

Her documentary film 'Life Begins at 90' about 95 year old Ray Woolley, a World War 2 veteran, (who was at the time the worlds' oldest active scuba diver), won the Best Short Documentary Film at the International Festival of Red Cross and Health Films, Varna, in 2019.

sands of volunteers have been trained, teams of professionals have been created to provide first psychological aid and psychosocial support, trained according to the methodology of the IFRC/PE.

As very good examples, we can point out: the construction of a Support Contact Center, located in the District Council of Red Cross - Plovdiv, the creation of a National online chat for psychosocial support, the conduct of free psychological consultations for people in need by Bulgarian Red Cross psychologists under various programs and projects.

At a time when aging is often perceived as a time of limitations and solitude, the IFRCHF is rewriting the script with a unique program. By showcasing films with positive portrayals of active and healthy aging, the festival inspires new perspectives and behaviors, encourages intergenerational dialogue, and guides a new approach to well-being. Promoting healthier and happier aging, solidarity, and support within communities are increasingly seen as cornerstones of improved quality of life.

Cinema is the ideal platform for bringing together older and younger generations, for appreciating and learning from each other, and for strengthening community bonds. This new film program can have a positive impact on the mental and physical health and well-being of older adults. The use of cultural activities as a tool for health promotion is a new interdisciplinary concept introduced by the IFRCHF

"Silver Screen" envisions regular screenings of a selection of films for the elderly audience in nursing homes, pensioner clubs, and other places of interest.

CINEMA IN BED

"Cinema in Bed" is another approach to reaching the audience, which the IFRCHFF piloted in 2020 due to the pandemic, broadcasting a selection of films through the local television network of St. Marina Hospital in Varna. In this way, the hospital patients (with 1,500 beds) followed the Festival daily. The feedback was for more films, a longer period, not just during the festival days, and advance program announcements. In 2022, we further developed this service at the IFRCHF Academy, which in 2023 we will see on a national scale, as well as through an online platform, llowing any sick person free access to quality cinema.



The story of a Ukrainian family living on the border of Russia and Ukraine. Irka refuses to leave her house even as the village gets captured by armed forces. Shortly after that they find themselves at the center of an international air crash catastrophe on July 17, 2014

It is July 2014 in Eastern Ukraine, near the Russian border, and the couple is already antsy about mounting hostility in the region, though most of the aggression is at this point invisible and off-screen. When deflagration shakes the walls of the modest house, they assume that a bomb may have hit the couple's house. But when the couple emerges from the basement, they find outside their home fragments from the crash of the Malaysia Airlines Flight 17, which was shot down on 17 July 2014. This improbable but all too real development adds to the odd quality of the film, and one of the film's strangest scenes sees the couple drive two Dutch parents looking for their missing daughter, one of the plane's 283 dead passengers. The accident is the

second 'mistake' from the involved military forces—the first was the bombing of the protagonists' house. Klondike is a matter-of-fact an angry film about war seen from the inside.


Małgorzata Gorol, picks up on her son's extraordinary gifts but must also contend with the reality of the little boy's condition. She is left all alone, revising her personal ambitions and facing up to the inadequacy of healthcare, welfare and education services vis-à-vis autistic children.

This is a panorama of powerlessness, anger, joy, contentment and then bitterness and disappointment once again. It's a celebration of women who are faced with discrimination, exclusion and home confinement. Dedicated, in fact, to "all the mothers who are forced to fight for their children".


